Event 1 The Opera

Scott Davis of English National Opera, who sang “Phantom” in *Phantom of the Opera* in the West End, has also performed in Culross. The list goes on and on. Event 2 Jazz & Blues Night

The Jazz & Blues night is loud, noisy and lots of fun. Many well known jazz musicians have performed at the Culross Festival over the years.
